Cemetery Land (Rachel)

- Lambing is done and dusted. 40 lambs have been docked from 30 ewes (133%, which is pretty good). All lambs have been vaccinated with 5 in 1 and scabbine'd as scabby mouth is an issue at the Cemetery Land. Both products donated by Jelanco Projects.
- We only lost the one ewe but have a few culls to take out after weaning.
- Grass cover is looking good although we will get some fert on once the ground dries out a bit.
- Trough still needs to be fitted in the back paddock. Water is not an issue though with the creek still flowing, but it will need to be done this month.
