3.1 Focus #1 – Walkway & Domain

- Walkway:
 - Great turn out for Working Bee! Thank you so much to all who turned up to plant & mulch
 - Next steps
 - o 3D Construction to pick up & drop off carpet as it becomes available.
 - Mulch ask Santoff Round Wood when they are next peeling (Rachel)
 - Calf muck mulch to be delivered to Levin St to put around 30 trees Vicki has planted (Rachel to get quote for delivery)
 - o Barley Straw to be delivered to either end of walkway and tractor to disperse.
 - o Andre to spray blackberry & gorse along railway fence.
- Other Walkway projects Triangle at end of Levin Street needs drainage sorting then topsoil and grassed. Aim is to have this done well before ANZAC Day 2019 as plans for this service include this area. Novoflow pipe (if required) could be funded from \$ allocated to walkway from \$2700 from MDC.

More effort needed with meeting and greeting new faces at the working bees.

3.2 Focus #2 - Hall & Hall Kitchen

- Wayne Winiata has done a revised quote for the kitchen.
- Discussed how far we need to go almost commercial vs just making it a bit more user-friendly.
- Decision was made to 'cut the cloth to suit' and only spend the \$8,000 already raised to make it more user friendly. Unanimously Agreed
